

Diabetic Chip



What it is?

- The chip preferably should be put in on your hand but can be put anywhere accessible for you
- The chip can be scanned by an app (called Diabetic Chip App) to check BP
- The chip can pump insulin when your BP is too high 120/80 or higher

How it's helpful?

- It helps diabetics keep track of their blood sugar level
- Gives diet suggestions
- Pumps insulin when needed

Where to get it and how to use it

- Ask Doctor before getting surgery
- Download “Diabetic Chip App”
- Scan the chip when needed
- Get BP
- Produces insulin when needed

Diabetic Chip App

1. Go to app
2. Hit sensor
3. Hold phone for 3 seconds over chip
4. App Tells you your blood pressure, Insulin level and Food and Health suggestions
5. Gives you a goal

Pros

- Don't have to inject yourself with insulin
- Can find blood sugar level quicker
- Not inconvenient in size

Cons

- Surgical implanted
- Patients would need to have a monthly check in since the insulin would need to be refilled
